Family Resource Centers

Friendly, accessible community hubs for families seeking information and referral, parenting classes, counseling, support groups and after-school programs in order to create nurturing, stable homes.

Home Visiting Programs

Educates families with children 0 to 5 years old considered at-risk for abuse with vital parenting education focused on bonding and attachment, developmental screenings, health and safety education, insurance information and community resources. Promotes and improves positive behavior and quality partnerships between parents and their children.

Dads Matter

Provides fathers and father figures living in Orange County with vital tools, resources and support to raise their children successfully while also strengthening family bonds.

Treatment

Family Foster Care & Adoption

Highly-regarded program finds safe, nurturing homes for children in need and permanent homes for those eligible for adoption.

Mental Health Services

Supports school-aged children who have experienced abuse or were at risk of abuse through mental health counseling.


